Summer fruit salad of ripe golden peaches, honeydew melon, nectarines and passion fruits, with hints of lime zest. From the award-winning winemaker that gave us 'Cloudy Bay'.		
Vinho Verde, Areal, Colheita Seleccionada, Portugal	29.95	7.50
A delightful little fizz sets this wine apart from others – lime zest and green apple on the palate gives this a real crisp freshness. Really light and great to drink on its own.

Spanish señorita dances on your palate with a kick of zippy citrus, almond and vanilla.		
Rioja Blanco, 'Cueva De Lobos', Javier San Pedro Ortega, Spain	26.95	6.75
A blend of Viura and White Tempranillo. Tropical fruit aromas of pineapple, banana and melon, and a well-structured and long finish – cries out for any kind of white fish.		
Viognier, Côtes de Thongue, Moulin Montarels, France	26.95	
Lively golden yellow in colour, complex aromas of peach, pear, apricot and honey. Beautifully fresh, a winner for any Viognier fan.		
Catarratto, 'Lucido', Sicilia DOC, Italy	26.95	
Intense straw yellow in colour with a delightful saline minerality on the finish. Fantastic on its own – lots of herbal and exotic notes with candied citrus.		
Chenin Blanc, Kleine Zalze, South Africa	22.95	5.75
Aromas of rich pineapple and guava jump out of the glass followed by a rich palate balanced with lovely freshness.

Dry and light to taste. Aromatic notes of freshly crushed cranberries and mineral elements.

Fleurie, Château de Fleurie, Domaine Loron, France

This lovely Fleurie is fruity with intense aromas of blackcurrants and blackberries, liquorice and black chocolate. It is rich and well balanced.

Warm and spicy

Demuerte One, Winery On, Spain

35.95

90% Monastrell, 10% Cabernet Sauvignon, aged in oak for 6 months. An abundance of ripe fruits on the nose. Soft tannins with subtle spice left lingering on the palate.

Rioja, De Alto Amo, 2020, Spain

26.95 6.75

Perfectly balanced with ripe, red fruits overlaid with mocha, wood spice and vanilla notes.

Rioja Crianza, 'Cueva De Lobos', Javier San Pedro Ortega, Spain

30.95

100% Tempranillo and aged in American and French oak barrels for 12 months. Ripe tannins make this an excellent food wine, however it is equally as good on its own.

Tempranillo, The Guv'nor, Felix Solis, Spain

Deep inky red in colour. Rich on the nose with black and red berry fruits. Smooth and silky to taste with a well-balanced pleasing finish.

Plummy fruit, soft tannins from some of the best estates to the west of Narbonne.

June, Asconi, Moldova

An easy-drinking blend of Merlot, Cabernet Sauvignon and Feteasca Neagra – a grape variety native to this area.

Made from a blend of grapes including Negroamaro, this wine is rich, fruity and moreish. Ruby red, dried leather and tobacco on the nose, sweet, dried fruits on the palate.

Côtes-du-Rhône, Château les Amoureuses, France

Full-bodied, medium acidity and ripe fruit flavours. A fantastic wine from the south Rhône.

Château Montaguillon, Montagne Saint-Émilion, 2018, France

Delicious supple red fruit character of plums, blackcurrants and cherries backed up by good structure and ripe tannins.

Dark and heavy

Barolo, Manfredi 2018, Italy

Rich mouthfeel with a good balance of acidity and tannin. Aromas of dried fruit and leather.

Châteauneuf-du-Pape, Les Galets de la Berthaude, Roger Perrin 2020, France

75.00

Slightly lighter than most but still full-bodied with rich, ripe fruits and a touch of spice. Mainly Grenache, with touches of Syrah and Mourvèdre.

Amarone Classico, Della Valpolicella DOCG, Campagnola, Italy

It doesn't get much better. Deep garnet red, vanilla and spice on the nose; black cherry, plum and bitter almond come through leaving a full, warm and velvety taste.
