Delicately fragrant with notes of almond and chamomile.		
<b>Beneath the Clouds Chardonnay 2021, Oak Valley, Elign – South Africa</b>		<b>34.95</b>
Generous stone fruit aromas, such as peach, with oatmeal and flint; followed with ruby grapefruit as the dominant character.		
<b>Albarino 2022, Pepe – the Lighthouse Keeper, Rias Baixas – Spain</b>		<b>37.95</b>
Apple and pear flavours combine with notes tropical fruit and an underlying minerality to produce a beautifully balanced wine.		
<b>Gruner Veltliner 2022, Crazy Creatures, Kremstal – Austria</b> (vg)		<b>39.95</b>
This most important grape in Austria and is known for its spicy, herbal but also fruity aroma and a crisp, fresh acidity.		
<b>Gewurztraminer 2020, Cave de Turckheim, Alsace – France</b> (vg)		<b>39.95</b>
Gentle aromas of rose petals and clementines, the restrained palate is lightly perfumed (as wild flower honey) and long.		
<b>Gavi del Comune di Gavi 2022, Tenuta Santa Seraffa, Piedmont – Italy</b> (vg)		<b>42.95</b>
Aromas of flora and citrus combined with an apple and lemon palate.		
<b>Sound of White 2022, Catalina Sounds, Malborough – New Zealand</b>		<b>47.95</b>
Fresh citrus on the nose with an intense flint minerality, and strong grapefruit palate. Fantastically fresh and fruity!		
<b>Sancerre 2020, Roblin Terres Blanches, Loire Valley – France</b> (vg)		<b>53.95</b>
Ripe fruit with good balance, picked early for freshness; aromas of white currants and nettles.		
<b>Chablis Grand Cru – Blanchot 2016, Patriarche, Chablis – France</b> (vg)		<b>89.95</b>
A predominantly floral aromatic strength and an evanescent minerality make it a great wine for Chablis enthusiasts.

Strong, robust, and dependable with dark, warm, chocolatey notes and a big savoury heart.		
<b>Pinot Noir 2022, Rare Vineyards, Languedoc-Roussillon – France (vg)</b>	<b>4.65</b>	<b>25.45</b>
If wine were footwear this would be a light summer deck shoe. Red cherries spring to mind.

This famous Bulgarian wine offers black cherries and berries, sweet spices, vanilla, and hints of black pepper and tobacco.

Cranberries, pomegranate with hints of star anise, black pepper, and a crushed graphite finish.

Rich cherry fruit, hints of capsicum, clove, and black pepper nose. Smooth berry fruit, and balanced tannin palate.

A real gem of a wine. Fruity and powerful, with immense smoothness and harmony.

A youthful wine with bite, texture, and a generosity of red fruit.

Fresh aromas of blackberry and raspberry; spicy and toasty background with hints of toffee, coffee and vanilla		
<b>Fleurie 2021, Chateau Domaine Loron, Beaujolais – France (vg)</b>		<b>38.95</b>
Vibrant red, with aromas of dark flowers and earth, followed by a silky palate of red berries.		
<b>Bordeaux Grand Vin 2019, Grand Moulin Macquin, Montagne Saint Emillion – France</b>		<b>44.95</b>
A full-bodied Bordeaux; elegant tannins, rich nose with soft spicy notes and hints of leather.		
<b>Trail 3150 2018, Oak Knoll, Napa Valley – USA (vg)</b>		<b>61.95</b>
A Merlot, Malbec, Cab Sav blend perfectly oaked to soften the wine and let the rich berry flavours speak for themselves.		
<b>Amarone 2017, Buglioni, Veneto – Italy</b>		<b>72.95.</b>
Aromas of black cherry, and white pepper with a soft, fresh, and elegant taste. The perfect pairing for braised meats.

Full Flavoured and warm with traces of liquorice and tobacco.		

## Rose Wine

A classic from Lombardia with fresh flavours of raspberry and strawberry with a lifting finish.

A fruit-forward-yet-bold red that is loved for its red fruit flavours and smoky exotic spice notes.		
<b>Merlot Cab Sav 2021, Domaine Boyar, Thracian Valley – Bulgaria (vg)</b>	<b>4.90</b>	<b>26.95</b>
Pale pink colour with coral hues. Fresh aromas of cherries and red berries on the nose. Fresh with notes of ripe red fruits.		
<b>Rosé Fleurie 2022, Château Barbe Belle, Provence – France (v)</b>	<b>6.75</b>	<b>36.95</b>
Light and subtle with tempting floral flavours of Watermelon, pink grapefruit, and Pomelo

Delicate, sweet spice aromas lead onto a palate which is soft, vinous, and round with abundant ripe fruit.

Sophisticated and very tempting aromas of fig jam, dried flowers, raisins, orange peel, apricot, quince, and honey. (200ml Bottle)		



# The Prae Wood Arms – Cellar Selection

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## White Wine

- Semillion Sauvignon 2021, Wildeberg, Costal Region – South Africa (vg) 6.60 35.95**  
Aromas of lemongrass, grapefruit, hay, and fennel. A textural mouthfeel of lanolin and lemons.
- Zibbibo Secco ‘Gagliardetta’ 2022, Curatolo Arini, Sicily – Italy 9.50 51.95**  
The single-vineyard Zibbibo (aka Muscat of Alexandria) is grown in vineyards in the western part of Sicily, just inland from Marsala. It is a dry, aromatic style which pairs perfectly with food.
- Prendas Vermentino 2021, Dolinova, Sardinia – Italy 45.95**  
A pale straw yellow with slight greenish glints with intensely floral, fresh, and fruity. On the palate it is intense and persistent, acidic, with delicate notes at the finish.
- Chassagne Montrachet 2015, Patriarche, Côte de Beaune - France 82.95**  
Structured Chardonnay with woody scents, honey, and dried tropical fruits; such as mango and lychee. With heavy oak and malolactic characters offering a creamy, buttery mouthfeel.

## Red Wine

- Shiraz 2022, Barossa Ink, Barossa Valley – Australia 5.85 31.95**  
From the heart of Barossa, Australia's Premium Shiraz growing region, this wine offers rich berry flavours with hints of mocha and dark chocolate in a bold and generous style.
- Old Vine Zinfandel 2019, Boneshaker, California – USA 9.15 49.95**  
Vibrant ruby red in colour, this Zin opens with aromas of dark cherry, blackberry, subtle notes of spice and a hint of leather. Perfect balance; ripe red berries and warm spices.
- Reserve Tannat 2020, Bodega Garzon, Maldonado – Uruguay 46.95**  
Deep purple, with aromas of plums and raspberries and just a hint of spice. A full-bodied wine with mature tannins complementing the dark juicy fruit and mineral notes.
- Pauillac - Grand Cru Classé 2012, Chateau Batailley, Bordeaux – France 139.95**  
Deep, dark, ruby red colour. Aromas of tobacco leaf, chocolate & pencil shavings. Very fresh acidity, leafy herbaceous fruit, and vivid cassis on the palate. Excellent freshness, balanced alcohol & good length. A little old fashioned, but noteworthy.



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## Rose Wine

- Rosada Cannonau 2020, Dolinova, Sardinia – Italy** 8.15 43.95  
Light pink colour with a delicate, elegant aroma; with notes of cherry and strawberry, giving way to a fine, fruity flavour, good structure and persistence.
- Whispering Angel 2020, Chateau d’Esclans, Provence – France** 64.95  
Made from Grenache, Cinsault and Rolle (Vermentino) grapes, its pale colour is pleasing to the eye and draws one in. The rewarding taste profile is full and lush while being bone dry with a smooth finish.

## Fizz

- Riesling 2020, Pet-Nat, Danube Plain - Bulgaria** 43.95  
Attractive apple and citrus notes, fine and persistent mousse and very pleasant, refreshing finish.
- Brut Réserve, Taittinger, Champagne – France (vg)** 94.95  
Greeted by aromas of fruit and brioche with peach, white flowers (hawthorn, acacia) and vanilla. The palate is lively, fresh with flavours of fresh fruit and honey.
- La Belle Epoque, Perrier Jouet, Champagne – France (vg)** 159.95  
A pale gold, clear and luminous, like an autumnal sun. Hitting the tongue with a lush, creamy texture. Floral notes of linden blossom, pear, mandarin, and grapefruit zest.

## Sweet Wine 50ml glass

- Trockenbeerenauslese 2017, Sepp Moser, Lower Austria - Austria** 10.95 64.95  
Aromas of honey and stone fruit. The palate is opulent with exotic fruit characters balanced by fresh, bright acidity and a lengthy finish. (375ml Bottle)
- Vidal Sparkling Icewine 2019, Inniskillin, Niagara – Canada** 89.95  
A twist on a classic, this demi-sec sparkling wine has plenty of tropical fruits, honey and citrus - try this with a fruit-based dessert. (375ml Bottle)
