A classic from Venetia. Delicate apple aromas with a zesty lemon touch for that true Italian flair.		
Sauvignon Blanc, Sea Point, South Africa	4.90	26.95
A zesty little number from South Africa made in the style of a New Zealand Sauvignon Blanc.		
Sauvignon Blanc, Milford Point, Marlborough, New Zealand	5.30	28.95
A corker of a Sauvignon Blanc, with a good squeeze of lemon and bags of tropical fruit.		
Chardonnay, Listening Station, Australia (vg)	4.00	21.95
Quintessentially Australian, unoaked with tangerine, grapefruit, lime and hint of spice.		
Chardonnay, Le Versant, France	4.20	22.95
Burgundy-style with a southern French suntan, elegant, buttery, nutty and a touch of oak.

A charming medium-sweet white wine, floral aromas with peaches and apricots to taste

An elegant classic white Bordeaux, with timeless flavours of lemon, cream, fennel and peaches.

Old school aromatic buttery loveliness. A big shaggy dog of a wine that licks you all over.		
Tempranillo Blanco Verdejo, Rioja Vega Blanco, Spain (vg)		23.95
Youthful fruity citrus flavours with hints of herbs on the finish, this is un-oaked and juicy.		
Alvarinho, Vila Nova, Portugal (vg)		27.95
Bright citrus aromas and a fresh, lively palate with ripe, tropical flavours. The underrated cousin of Spain's Albariño, but so much more interesting.		
Grüner Veltliner, Organic, Sepp Moser, Austria (vg)		29.95
A terrific dry white wine from Austria, zippy grapefruit flavours with white pepper finish.		
Sauvignon Blanc, Passing Giants, Organic, Marlborough, New Zealand (vg)		34.95
Cruelly short vintage has resulted in a great concentration of fruit, a classic Marlborough with bags of pink grapefruit.

Shiraz, Excelsior, South Africa	4.20	22.95
This bright, jammy Shiraz is bursting with juicy flavours of dark berries, cherry, plum and hints of chocolate and spices.		
Malbec, Tanners, Mendoza, Argentina (vg)	4.55	24.95
Our good friends, Tanners, have produced this juicy wine. A real all-rounder.		
Merlot, Pacamaya, Chile (vg)	4.20	22.95
Soft, rounded, plummy fruit flavours with a gentle sustained finish. A cuddle in a glass.		
Cabernet Sauvignon, Tanners, Mendoza, Chile (vg)	4.55	24.95
Perfumed and fresh, majoring on blackcurrant with hints of liquorice and sweet cinnamon.		
Grenache Syrah, Les Coteaux, Côtes du Rhône Villages, France (vg)		26.95
A real gem of a wine. Fruity and powerful, with immense smoothness and harmony.		
Gamay, Fleurie Château de Fleurie, Domaine Loron, Beaujolais, France (vg)		29.95
Dark fruit and black chocolate aromas. Well balanced with silky tannins and a persistent finish.		
Primitivo, Conviviale, Salento, Italy (vg)		22.95
Rich with bramble fruit and a hint of sweet spice. Ripe tannins balanced by fresh acidity.		
Merlot, Fiorebella Rosso Appassimento, Vento, Italy (vg)		26.95
Intense ruby-red, bags of dark fruit, soft and round thanks to American and French oak.		
Tempranillo, Artesa, Organic, Rioja, Spain		28.95
Fresh redcurrant and cherry aromas with woody, herbal notes.		
Carignan, Debajo Dry Farmed, Chile (vg)		22.95
Red berries and juicy, fresh with a gentle seam of tannin structure. This is a juicy, aromatic bottle of joy!

A vibrant rosé with a vivid aroma of red summer fruit, enticing wild strawberry and raspberry dominating the stylish and elegant palate.		

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
